







In this annual report, we are pleased to share insights on the Trust's 2017 sponsorships that reinforce our community's spirit of giving and compassion.

Our Year of Giving

During 2017, the Trust sponsored 120 nonprofits across the United States. Additionally, donations were made to 28 colleges and secondary schools through the matching gift program and three post-secondary risk management programs received donations, two in the form of academic scholarships.

OneBeacon Scholarship Program

For the fourteenth consecutive year, OneBeacon recognized deserving high-school seniors with college scholarships. Sixteen \$2,000 awards were distributed, including eight to OneBeacon employees' children and eight to children of the company's distribution partners. Winners were selected based on criteria such as academic record, leadership skills and participation in school and community activities.
